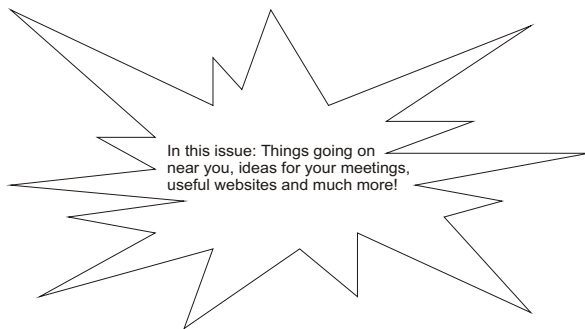

Make your own Jolly Jellyfish

Here's a great use for all those free computer CDs that you no longer need - a jolly jellyfish to Hang in a window.



1. Cut up 10 strips of coloured paper - they need to be about 2cm wide and 30cm long. Use stickers or other pieces of coloured paper to decorate your strips.
2. Use glue to stick the ends of the strips all around the edge of a CD. You need to glue on the side with the writing.
3. Spread more glue over the CD. Push the ends of the ribbon up through the middle hole and glue them down at opposite sides.
4. Dab a bit more glue on top and sandwich the other CD - writing side down - on top.
5. Stick the eyes right next to each other on the edge of the jellyfish.
6. When the glue is dry, the jellyfish is ready to hang up. You may need to adjust the hanging loop so that the front of the loop is shorter than the back.
